The Corona crisis has exposed the flaws in the systems of government and their inability to provide an efficient response.

It proved that citizens have no influence over the decisions of their elected representatives - a helplessness that connects to a crisis of confidence in all systems of government.

In the face of paralysis and failure in all areas, we must change direction, organize as a civic public and formulate new ways to gain influence and get involved.

The **"Israeli Movement"** assists in the establishment of local communities throughout the country and promotes the leadership that they bring forward.

The local communities, combined with professional forums, will formulate professional work plans and lead actions for change at the local level.

The community network will work together and lead the **"Israeli Movement"** to a profound change in the political and social structure in Israel.

The movement will return to citizens authority and influence over their lives and will provide real representation in the political space.

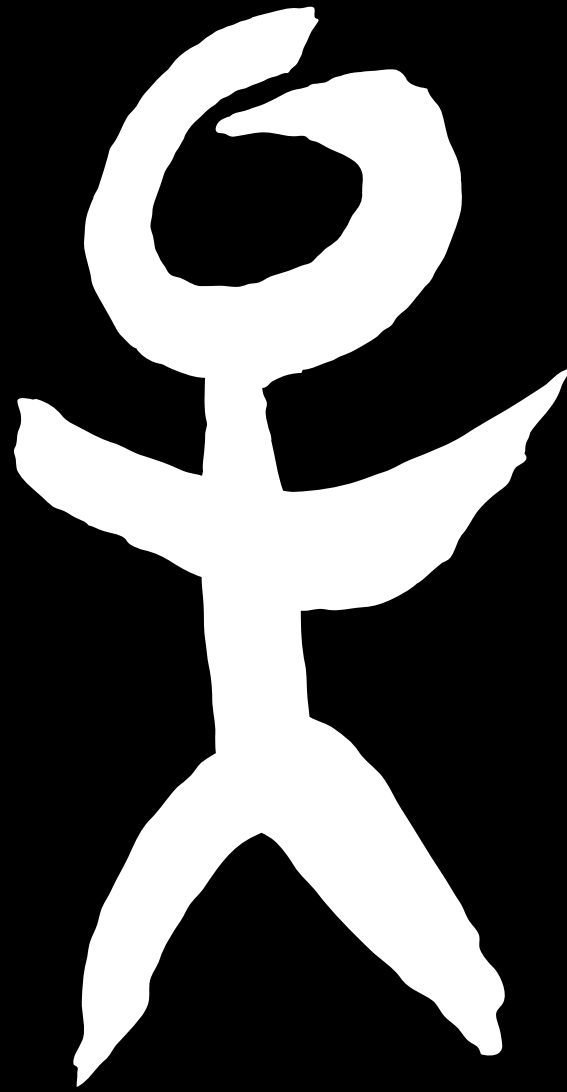
This is an **"Israeli movement"** for a new communal pact based on shared principles, democracy, solidarity and justice.

How do we motivate?

Our main goals and courses of action are:

- **Connection** - Establishment of local-regional and national-themed communities for joint action. Defining problems at the local level, supporting community processes and mapping cross-cutting issues that concern most residents.
- **Growth** - Fostering and training authentic local leadership attentive to the needs of the residents. Establishment of leading teams where community representatives and professional teams work together to solve common problems for communities.
- **Networking** - Connecting and linking communities, establishing an urban community with the power to deal with problems and influence and strengthen local government.
- **Organization** - Connecting communities to the "Israeli Movement" which works to promote values and principles shared and agreed upon with the governing authorities and the political system.
- **Influence** - On the local and national political system to guide it to action based on principles of planning, management and adaptation to the needs of citizens.
- **Change** - Put representatives in positions of influence in local and national government authorities, work to influence the environment, society and the state to effect profound change in the political and social structure in Israel, deepen and securing democracy and to empower all citizens.
